Tour Fact Sheet & Bird Highlight

Cat Tien > Germain's Peacock-pheasant, Green Peafowl, Orange-necked Partridge, Blue-rumped Pitta, Bar-bellied Pitta, Siamese Fireback, Scaly-breasted Partridge, Woolly-necked Stork, Lesser Adjutant; White-bellied, Great Slaty, Pale-headed, Black-and-buff and Heart-spotted Woodpeckers, Great Hornbill, Banded Kingfisher and the Indochinese-endemic Grey-faced Tit-Babbler.

Di Linh > Spotted Forktail, Blue Pitta, Rufous-browed Flycatcher, Black-hooded and Orange-breasted Laughingthrush, Black-crowned Parrotbill, Red-billed Scimitar Babbler, Indochinese Cuckooshrike, Annam Barbet.

Da Lat > Grey-crowned Crocias, Orange-breasted Laughingthrush, Hume's Treecreeper, Yellow-billed Nuthatch, Grey-crowned Tit, Vietnamese Cutia, Black-crowned Fulvetta, Collared Laughingthrush, indochinese Cuckooshrike, Slender-billed Oriole, Burmese Shrike, Red Crossbill and Vietnamese Greenfinch, Da Lat Shrike Babbler, Annam Barbet, Black-hooded Laughingthrush, White-cheeked Laughingthrush.

Habitats Covered : Broadleaved evergreen forest, Rice Field, Mountain Forest, Pine Forest, Bamboo Forest, Evergreen Forest

Destination : Ho Chin Min City - Cat Tien - Da Lat - Di Linh
Duration : 7 days Tour
Tour Start & End : Ho Chin Min City

Day 1 : Ho Chin Min City > Cat Tien National Park.

07:00 bird leader pick you up at Hotel

For pick you up at the **Tan Son Nhat Airport** flight detail.....

Transfer 4 hr. to Cat Tien National Park contains the largest remaining area of lowland tropical forest in southern Vietnam and an incredible diversity of birds and mammals. Endangered birds found at Cat Tien include Germain's Peacock-pheasant, Green Peafowl and the very elusive Orange-necked Partridge while the mammal list includes Leopard Cat, Lesser Mousedeer, Sambar, Gaur and two endangered primates, Black-shanked Douc Langur and Buff-cheeked Gibbon.

Overnight : Guest House national park (air-con., hot shower)

Day 2,3 : Cat Tien

Three days birding at Cat Tien National Park. There are excellent trails starting right at the park headquarters and for areas further field such as Crocodile Lake by jeeps. The 5 km walk through semi-evergreen forest to Crocodile Lake is a great place to look for the near-endemic Germain's Peacock-pheasant, Blue-rumped and Bar-bellied Pittas while Siamese Fireback can often be seen on an early morning drive through the park. Among the many other avian treats to be found at Cat Tien are Scaly-breasted Partridge, Woolly-necked Stork, Lesser Adjutant, White-bellied, Great Slaty, Pale-headed, Black-and-buff and Heart-spotted Woodpeckers, three species of broadbill and the Indochinese-endemic Grey-faced Tit-Babbler.

Day 4 : Cat Tien > Di Linh

Leave Cat Tien transfer 5-6 hr. to Di Linh town, 20 km driving from Di Linh to Suoi Lanh pass is a excellence place for Spotted Forktail, Blue Pitta, Black-hooded and Orange-breasted Laughingthrush, Black-crowned Parrotbill, Red-billed Scimitar Babbler, Indochinese Cuckooshrike, Annam Barbet.

Overnight : Nhat Minh Hotel

Day 5, 6 : Di Linh > Da Lat

Transfer 3 hr. to Da Lat and then full Day in side park by local truck, searching for Grey-crowned Crocias, Orange-breasted Laughingthrush, Hume's Treecreeper, Yellow-billed Nuthatch, Gray-crowned Tit, Vietnamese Cutia, Black-crowned Fulvetta, Collared Laughingthrush, Indochinese Cuckooshrike, Slender-billed Oriole, Burmese Shrike, Red Crossbill and Vietnamese Greenfinch, Da Lat Shrike Babbler, Annam Barbet, Black-hooded Laughingthrush, White-cheeked Laughingthrush.

Overnight : Thien An Hotel

Day 7 : Da Lat > Da Lat Airport > Ho Chi Minh City

Early morning birding at Da Lat National Park, transfer to Da Lat airport for domestic flight to Ho Chi Minh City or to Tan Son Nhat International Airport for departure flight.
