9 Days Key Site, Myanmar Tour

Destination : Yangon – Bagan – Mt. Victoria

Duration : 9 days Tour

Expect to see : 190 specie +

Day 1 : Yangon

Tour starts in Yangon after arriving with a morning flight. We will check in a Hotel and get things settled and organized. After lunch we will be sightseeing downtown Yangon. Those who have not been to Myanmar before will visit the famous **Shwedagon Pagoda** later in the evening.

Overnight: Myanmar Life Hotel Click! (free WIFI)

Day 2 : Yangon > Bagan

Early in the morning we will be flying to **Bagan**, one of the richest archeological sites in South east Asia. We will spend 2 full days in Bagan, You will be birding in ancient ruins more than a thousand years old and will be seeing 4 endemics birds of Burma which are *White-throated Babbler*, *Burmese Bushlark*, *Jerdon's Minivet* and *Hooded Treepie* together with other interesting birds.

Day 3 : Irrawaddy River

Birdwatching on the big boat, we spend 2 time of a day for birdwatching along the Irrawaddy river, 06:00-10:30 and 15:00-18:00, after late morning turn back to lunch on main land, sightseeing pagoda around Bagan, and then turn back to shoot bird on the boat again. Bird highlight is White-tailed Stone Chat, Sandlark, Striated Babbler, Indian Spot billed Duck, Ruddy Shelducks, Small Pratincole, along with other water birds.

Day 4 : Bagan > Mt. Victoria

Early morning we will drive about an hour to a town called **Chauk** with a 4WD vehicle where we will cross the Irrawaddy River to begin our journey to the Chin Hills. In the lowland forest along the way we will look out for the endemic *Hooded Treepie*, *Jerdon's Minivet*, *Burmese Bushlark*, *White throated*



Babbler and other special species such as Alexandrine, Grey-headed, Red-breasted and Blossom-headed Parakeets, White-rumped Falcon, White-eyed Buzzard, Woodpeckers, Babblers, Laughingthrushes, Minivets, Orioles, Chinese Francolin, Red Junglefowl, Green Pigeons and many more. Our destination is to a basic and comfortable lodge in Kanpetlet. Kanpetlet is a town in Chin State, the nearest to central Myanmar. It is situated at 1400 mls. south-east of Mt. Victoria which is also called Khaw-nu-thone in Chin and Nat-ma-taung in Myanmar, meaning Mother of Spirits, in both languages. We will spend all Mt. Victoria nights at the lodge where the temperature is cool and pleasant.

Day 5 - 7 : Mt. Victoria - Small Pool

We will be birding in the Nat-ma-taung (Mt. Victoria) National Park which comprises 179 sq. miles summit 3,110 meters high and is home to the endemic White-browed Nuthatch, Black browed Tit (Burmese Tit) and new one endemic is Mt. Victoria Barbax. Various types of habitats on the mountain such as mixed oak and rhododendrons, Montane bamboo patches, broad leaf evergreen forest, Pine forest, thick secondary growth with tall grass and scrub, semi cultivated fields and grass lands are rich in birds and a number of specialties like Brown-capped Laughing-thrush, Black-headed Shrike Babbler, Grey Sibia, Blue-winged Laughingthrush, Assam Laughingthrush, Striped Laughingthrush, Slender-billed Scimitar Babbler, Spot-breasted Scimitar Babbler, Brown Bush-Warbler, Russet Bush Warbler, Broad-billed Warbler, and Spot-breasted Parrotbill can be found.

During our days in Mt. Victoria (Nat-ma-taung) National Park we will be exploring different elevations with different habitats every day. Birds like Grey sided Thrush, Orange flanked Bush Robins, and sometimes, Kalij Pheasants are usually seen on the road when we drive up the mountain every morning. 5 species of Nuthatches are found at 5 different elevations, the White-browed at the highest and the Velvet-fronted at the lowest. Great birds like Blyth's Tragopan and Hume's Pheasant are also a possibility. Rare and colorful birds like Fire tailed Sunbird, Gould's Sunbird, Cutia, Chestnut-tailed Minla, Blue-Winged Minla, Scarlet Finch, Minivets, Robins, and Flycatchers. **Small Pool** guide make two of small pools at dry stream, do not waiting for long time to bird coming bird such as Chestnut-headed Tesia, Grey-bellied Tesia, Black-faced Warbler, Grey-crowned Warbler, Mt.Victoria Babax, 3 specie Laughing-thrush, Chin Hills Wren-Babbler, Scaly-breasted Wren-Babbler, Pygmy Wren-Babbler, Silver-eared Mesia and more.

Day 8 : Mt.Victoria > Bagan

Full day drive back to Bagan and those who have missed the lowland specialties will have a chance to find it again.

Day 9 : Bagan > Yangon

We will fly back to Yangon with a morning flight.
