

Thailand Doi Inthanon More Than You Expect



Doi Inthanon Thailand's highest mountain, elevation 2,825 m., is undoubtedly the foremost bird watching locality in Northern Thailand: 343 species recorded so far [1994]. The metalled access road branches west off Highway 108, 58 km southwest of Chiang Mai and 1 km. before **Chom Thong** and extends 46 km. to summit of mountain.

A Good Place For Birding

Dry Dipterocarp at Km. 9 on lower slopes, which support wintering *Grey Bushchats, Buff-throated, Radde's* and *Yellow-streaked Warblers*, *Grey- faced Buzzard* good spot to see Collared Falconet, White-rumped Falcon, Eurasian Jay, Large Cuckoo-shrike.

Waterfall and Streams good place to see *Slaty-backed Forktail, Blue Whistling Thrush, Plumbeous Redstart, White-capped Redstart.*

Hill evergreen forest above 1,500 msl. grades into lower-stature, almost montane-type forest around the summit, where small marsh surrounded by rhododendrons proves very attractive to winter visitors. There are usually five or six *Red-flanked Bluetails* in the vicinity and, in good years, large, mixed thrush flocks. Predominant leaf-warblers are the two resident species, *White-tailed* and *Ashy-throated*, together with wintering *Orange-barred*. Flocks of *Scarlet Rosefinches* are often present and frequently contain occasional surprise visitor, such as *Dark-breasted Rosefinch*, *Rufouse-bellied Niltava*, *White-gorgetged Flycather*, *White-browed Scimitar-Babbler*, *Yellow-checked Tit*, *Dark-backed Sibia*, *Grey-cheecked Fulvetta*, *Rufous-winged Fulvetta*, *Silver-eared Mesia*, *Spectacled Barwing*, *Scarlet Minivet*, *Mountain Bulbul*, *Slaty-bellied Tesia*, *Lesser Shortwing and more*.

Summit at 2,285 msl. cover by hill every green forest bird highlight is **Green-tailed Sunbird**, Mrs.Gould's sunbird, Chestnut-crowned Laughingthrush, Chestnut-tailed Minla, Flavescent Bulbul, Rufousthroated Partridge, Speckled Wood-Pigeon and more.

2. CANCELLATION THE TOUR POLICY

The business partner and client shall notify us in writing of any cancellation prior to the minimum notice dates, otherwise a late cancellation charge will be applied as follows:

In case of cancellation within 60 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 50% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 30 days before the tour start. It is no refund in any case.

In case of No show during the tour. It is no refund in any case.

3. POSTPONE THE TOUR POLICY

In case of postpone 60 days before program tour start, We will not deduct any business opportunity loss fees. We'll refund you the amount incurred after deducting the transfer fee or keep it with us. We will issue a credit note for the next use with a period of 6 months from the date of request to postpone the tour. After that, if you are still unable to determine the next travel date, We will transfer the money back to you for the amount incurred less the transfer fee.

In case of postpone during 30 days before program tour start, In the event that you request to postpone the travel date of the tour for reasons in all cases. We will charge from you 50% of the total tour cost incurred as a result of the loss of business opportunity. The remaining amount will be
