

2 Days Khao Yai National Park Mission Possible



* Khao Yai * is a first national park in Thailand. It lies largely in Nakhon Ratchasima Province (Khorat), but also includes parts of Saraburi, Prachinburi and Nakhon Nayok provinces. It was the country's first national park, established on September 18, 1962. A major role in its establishment was done by Boonsong Lekakul, one of the 20th century's most famous conservationists in Thailand.

A total of 333 species of birds and 71 species of mammals have been reported in Khao Yai. The montane bird fauna is not well represented in Khao Yai, not only because the park is relatively remote from the higher

forested mountains of the north and west, but partly because it has only small, isolated areas of unexceptionally high mountain tops. Some typical montane birds include the *White-tailed Leaf-Warbler*, both of which may be found around Khao Khiew and the other high peaks. Khao Yai bird fauna is chiefly composed of those lowland and hill slope (submontane) birds, which

have fairly wide latitudinal ranges. Some other lowland species, such as Siamese Fireback may once have been abundant in the evergreen forests which formerly covered the surrounding plain, are found only at extremely low density around the Khao Yai



headquarters area. Some typical resident species inhabiting the evergreen forests of the headquarters area include Silver Pheasant(hard), Vernal Hanging Parrot, Green-billed Malkoha, Mountain Imperial Pigeon, Orange-breasted and Red-headed Trogons, four species of hornbills, 3 barbets, Greater Flameback and Heart-spotted Woodpecker(hard), 4 species of broadbills(usually in summer), **Blue Pitta** (photo by KC Choo), Blue-winged Leafbird, Asian Fairy bluebird, a variety of bulbuls, including the Puff-throated and Grey-eyed Bulbul, Greater Racket-tailed Drongo, Green Magpie, Abbott's Babbler, White-bellied Yuhina, Dark-necked Tailorbird, Hill Blue Flycatcher, White-throated Kingfisher, Indian Roller, Chestnut-capped Babbler, Bright-capped Cisticola. Khao Yai is host to many migrant or wintering birds.

Day 1: Khao Yai

The entrance to Khao Yai National Park opens at 6:00 AM. and we were ready to go bird watching in Khao Yai National Park for the main reason of only one bird that we had to see early in the morning, which was the Silver Pheasant.

If you're in Africa, you'll want to find the Big Five in the savannah. This term was coined by big game hunters to refer to the five hardest animals in Africa to hunt on foot. Khao Yai National Park also has big fives, but this time with a camera. There are five birds you should see: 1) Silver Pheasant 2) Eared Pitta3) Coral-billed Ground Cuckoo 4) Siamese Fireback 5) Great Hornbill.

That means your guide and driver will have to work hard these 2 days to see them.!!

Day 2: Khao Yai

We have many key spot to see bird as such as **Haew Narok waterfall**, a biggest waterfall in South-east Asia bird highlight is Van Hasselt's, Crimson, Olive-backed, Ruby-cheeked Sunbird. **Zone Thanarat Bungalow** habitat here is scrub, glass filed, forest edge bird as such Hill Myna, Chestnutheaded Bee-eater, Heart-spotted Woodpecker, etc. **Khao Khiew road:** Orange-breasted Trogon, Redheaded Trogon, Blue Pitta, Siamese Fireback, Coral-billed Ground Cuckoo, Greater Flameback, Thick-billed Pigeon, etc. **Pha Diew Dai** view point, habitat which is an evergreen forest and hill forest. Bird as such Silver Pheasant (this's one only found in morning), Red-headed Trogon, Black-throated Laughingthrush, Puff-throated Babbler and more. **Pha Kaw Mai Campsite** Orange headed Thrush, Siberian Blue Robin, Hainan Blue Flycatcher and around camp ground you can see 5 specie of Flowerpecker bird such as Buff-breasted, Yellow-vented, Fire-breasted, Plain, Scarlet-backed Flowerpecker, Great, Wreath Hornbill, White-crested Laughingthrush, White-browed Scimitar-Babbler, Eared, Blue Pitta, Banded Kingfisher, Long-tailed Broadbill **Haew Suwat waterfall trail 2.8 km.**: White-crowned Forktail, Slaty-backed Forktail, Blue-eared Kingfisher.

Night Safari 19:00-20:00, Today we will have to have dinner early or late depending on what time the group wants to start watching animals, but the best time is from 7 pm to 8 pm. You will have a chance to see nocturnal animals such as Jackal, Malayan Porcupine, Dhole, 2-3 specie of Civet Cat, Leopard Cat, Elephant, Sambar Deer, Great-eared Nightjar, Buffy-fish Owl and more. **(NOT INCLUDED TOUR PRICE)**



For mammal day time: Asian Elephant, White-handed Gibbon, Pileated Gibbon, Pig-tailed Macaque, Sambar Deer, Barking Deer, Black Giant Squirrel, Serow and more.

17:00 pm. Transfer back to hotel located in Khao Yai area.

1. PAYMENTS POLICY

2. CANCELLATION THE TOUR POLICY

The business partner and client shall notify us in writing of any cancellation prior to the minimum notice dates, otherwise a late cancellation charge will be applied as follows:

In case of cancellation before 90 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 0% of the total amount in any case, Company refund money back to you 100%.



In case of cancellation within 90 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 15% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 60 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 50% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 30 days before the tour start. It is no refund in any case.

In case of No show during the tour. It is no refund in any case.

3. POSTPONE THE TOUR POLICY

In case of postpone 60 days before program tour start, We will not deduct any business opportunity loss fees. We'll refund you the amount incurred after deducting the transfer fee or keep it with us. We will issue a credit note for the next use with a period of 6 months from the date of request to postpone the tour. After that, if you are still unable to determine the next travel date, We will transfer the money back to you for the amount incurred less the transfer fee.

In case of postpone during 30 days before program tour start, In the event that you request to postpone the travel date of the tour for reasons in all cases.
