Two of the best birding sites in the south west are on the same trip. You will see small and medium-sized birds in the wild, but for larger birds such as Hornbills, Fish-eagle It may not be easy because the forest is overgrown with trees making it difficult to see.

Day 1 : Phuket > Khao Sok

06:30 Driver in Phuket pick you up at the lobby hotel

Then transfer 2 - 2.30 hours to meet your guide at **Khao Sok national park**, Gai is the only birder expert in this area, he will take you to birdwatching spots and other key locations within Khao Sok National Park **Bird highlight** : Rufous-collared, Banded, Blue-banded Kingfisher, Chestnut-napped Forktail, Great Iora, Blue-winged Leafbird, Rufous Piculet, Buff-Vented, Yellow-bellied, Cream-vented, Red-eyed, Spectacled Bulbul, Red-throated Barbet, Grey-capped, Bamboo, Banded Woodpecker, Lesser Cuckoo-shrike, Bar-bellied Cuckoo-shrike, Little, Purple-napped, Plain Sunbird, Spectacled, Yellow-eared Spiderhunter Brown-throated, Orange-bellied, Yellow-vented, Thick-billed Flowerpecker.

Day 2 : Khao Sok > Sri Phang Nga

A few hours to birding inside **Khao Sok**, Then transfer 1 hour to **Sri Phang Nga national park** with guide Gai, here also same habitat as Khao Sok is a rain forest a home of 250 birds example is Gloud's, Javan Frogmouth, Banded Pitta, Red-breaded Bee-eater, Crested Jay, Asian Paradise Flycatcher, Blue-banded Kingfisher, Chestnut-napped Forktail, Buff-Vented Bulbul, Yellow-bellied Bulbul, Purple-naped Sunbird, Red-throated Barbet, Grey-capped Woodpecker, Lesser Cuckoo-shrike, Bar-bellied Cuckoo-shrike and more.

On evening transfer 20 min. to the best resort in Kuraburi town, guide Gai bring you to see Brown Wood Owl at rooting spot.

Day 3 : Sri Phang Nga > Phuket

A few hours birding at **Thung Chale substation forest** the location near the resort. Then transfer 20 min. back to birding inside Sri Phang Nga np.

After lunch, around 3:00 p.m., the sun began to not be so hot. Your guide will take you bird watching at **Khleng Sang Nae** or Little Amazon. Takua Pa is only 2 miles away.

This is a short canal. that originates from Khao Bang Tao before ending at the Takua Pa River. There is a small forest area. that is full of biological diversity Strange plants that grow Along the banks of Khleng Sang Neh Most tourists come to take a canoe to admire the beauty of nature at Khleng Sang Nae. It is to see the ancient banyan tree, hundreds of years old, spreading its branches along the canal. In some parts it hangs in front of us like a curtain of a banyan tree tunnel for you to take a boat ride through. Another highlight of the cruise. It is to see snakes, including Green Snakes, Mangrove snake (*Boiga dendrophila*), and pythons, which you don't have to be afraid of being dangerous because we are watching the snakes from a distance. And during the day the snake will sleep still. It curls up against a tree and waits to come out to feed at night. But for bird watching The guide will take you on a bird-watching tour on the 200-meter cement walkway. Some of the common local birds include: Ruddy Kingfisher, Mangrove Pitta, Black-and-Red Broadbill, Chestnut-breasted Malkoha, Orange-bellied Flowerpecker, Van Hansell's Sunbird, Olive-winged Bulbul, etc.



Then drive 10 min. to **Kotiean open area** many specie show up here such as Raptors & Eagle, Red-throated Pipit, River & Grey-headed Lapwing, White-shouldered, Black-collared Starling, Little Green, Blue-tailed Bee-eater, Watercock, Purple Swamphen, Oriental Pratincole, Pacific Golden, Grey Plover, Wood & Common Sandpiper, Plaintive Cuckoo, Common Flameback, White-rumped Munia some time see Oriental Plover(rare).

16:00 Drop guide Gai at **Takau Pa bus station**, driver and you transfer 2 hours back to Phuket drop you at the place you desire.....

CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT AND TOUR SERVICE POLICY

1. PAYMENTS POLICY & CONFIRM BOOKING

The payments can be made via **Banking**, **Wise**, **PayPal** You can pay in the full amount 100% or confirm your booking we need at least 25% deposit. Immediate payment, your booking will record and confirm.



2. CANCELLATION THE TOUR POLICY

The business partner and client shall notify us in writing of any cancellation prior to the minimum notice dates, otherwise a late cancellation charge will be applied as follows :

In case of cancellation before 120 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 0% of the total amount in any case, Company refund money back to you 100%.

In case of cancellation within 90 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 35% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 60 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 50% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 30 days before the tour start. It is no refund in any case.

In case of No show during the tour. It is no refund in any case.

3. POSTPONE THE TOUR POLICY

In the case of postpone 60 days before program tour start, We will not deduct any business opportunity loss fees. We'll refund you the amount incurred after deducting the transfer fee or keep it with us. We will issue a credit note for the next use with a period of 6 months from the date of request to postpone the tour. After that, if you are still unable to determine the next travel date, We will transfer the money back to you for the amount incurred less the transfer fee.

In the case of postpone during 30 days before program tour start, In the event that you request to postpone the travel date of the tour for reasons in all cases. We will collect or deduct from you 50% of the total tour cost incurred as a result of the loss of business opportunity. The remaining amount will be refunded to you based on the amount accrued less after the transfer fee. And there is no policy to collect money as credit notes.

In the case postpone less than 30 days before program tour start, It is no refund in any case.

4. DISPUTES, ACTIONS, OR OTHER MATTERS ARISING
